

# MEDICATION MANAGEMENT CHART

You are free to use this chart, and modify it in any way possible, to enable this form to be useful to you. Dosage of pain medication may be increased over time. Medication may change due to changes in administration methods (e.g., changing from pill to liquid medication). Medication changes in hospice are very, very frequent. The frequency (how often) and the dose (how much) will change over time.

This form is a way to keep track of the changes, and by recording the date, you will know what is the most current for you and other caregivers. The hospice nurse will inform you of the changes. Also, many home hospice services will provide you with a form. But if you do not receive one, you can use this form if it is helpful to you.

Definitions: QD = once/day, BID = twice/day, TID = 3 times/day, QID = 4 times/day, Q\_ H, where the dosage is given every \_\_ hours [Example: Q6H means every six hours]
